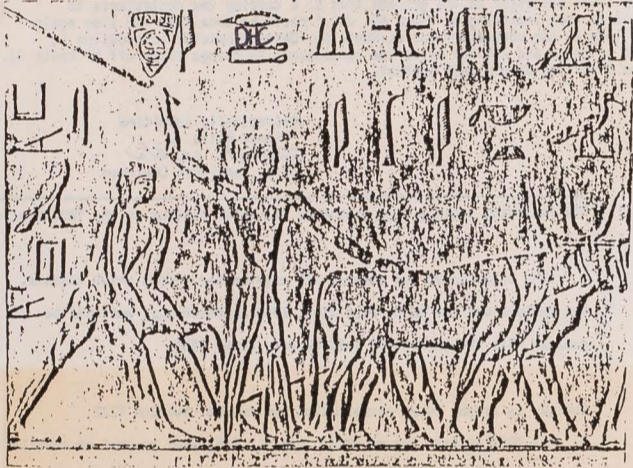

Motor club to sponsor road rally

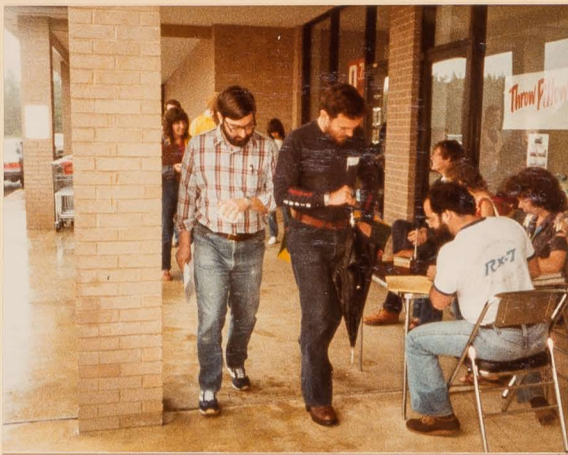
The Virginia Motor Sport Club will sponsor several events in May as a part of its monthly activities, including an autocross and a road rally to take place later this month.
