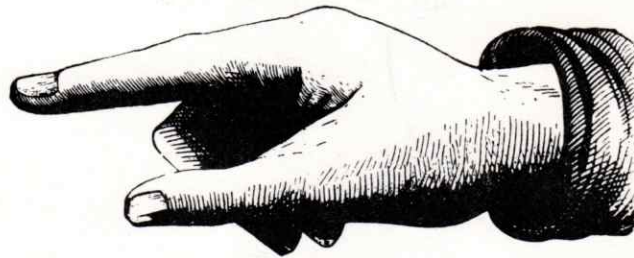

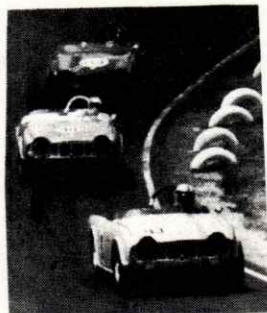
The Triumph Spitfire

was the Class D Modified Champion in the only division entered—Pacific Coast.



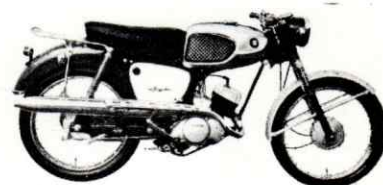
The Triumph TR-3

BY-LAWS
of the
VIRGINIA MOTOR SPORT CLUB, INCORPORATED

Written 7 May 1958

Revised February, 1961

Article I

The name of this corporation, hereinafter sometimes called "The Club", shall be

"VIRGINIA MOTOR SPORT CLUB, INC."

Article II
Object

To stimulate and promote interest in the sport of motoring.

Article III
Membership

I. Regular Members

Membership in the Club shall be restricted to persons who are interested in the Club and its objectives. Applications for membership, accompanied by payment of the initiation fee and annual dues, must be signed by two members in good standing and approved by the Board of Directors.

II. Honorary Members

Honorary membership may be conferred on any nominee by a majority vote of the membership.

III. Guest

Members may bring guests to all functions except those designated as closed events. Guest privileges shall not be extended for other than regular meetings more than two (2) times. This restriction shall not apply to members of other recognized sports car clubs.

IV. Life Members

Members who have maintained Regular Membership in the Club for eight years shall receive Life Member status. Life Members shall not be required to pay annual dues and shall receive all privileges of Regular Membership. (November, 1964)

Article IV

Dues

- I. Annual Dues shall be \$5 and shall be payable on or before January 1.
- II. Honorary members shall not be required to pay dues.
- III. Applications received - from new applicants - after June 30 will be charged one-half (1/2) of annual dues.

Article V

Initiation Fee

- I. Initiation Fee of \$5.00 will be charged for all new members and any members 30 days in arrears.

Article VI

Annual Meeting

- I. The annual meeting shall be held in December of each year for the purpose of receiving final reports of all offices and election of new officers from the nominations submitted in November. The results shall be announced at the Annual Banquet in January of each year.

II. Special Meetings

- I. Special meetings of the Club may be held upon call of either the President or the Board of Directors, or upon request of 20% of the Club members.

III. Notices

A written notice of the annual Club meeting shall be mailed so as to be received by members at least six (6) days before the time of the meetings.

IV. Quorum

Ten (10) or 10%, whichever is greater, members in good standing and present shall constitute a quorum at all meetings.

Article VIII
Officers and Directors

- I. The Officers of the Club shall be a President, Executive Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, and Treasurer, who shall be elected annually by the Members.
- II. The Officers of the Club shall appoint a Board of Directors to serve for a period of one year.

Article VIII
Duties of Officers

I. President

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Club and of the Board of Directors. He may appoint such committees as he may deem necessary to the proper operation of the Club.

II. Executive Vice President

He shall assist the President in all matters. He shall preside at all meetings in the absence of the President.

III. 2nd Vice President

He shall schedule, coordinate and organize all activities of the Club.

IV. Secretary

The Secretary shall keep minutes of all meetings, maintain an accurate record of membership, conduct all official correspondence, maintain accurate record of Point Standings for all members of the Club.

V. Assistant Secretary

The Assistant Secretary will assist the Secretary in all secretarial duties.

VI. Treasurer

He shall be responsible for collection of all dues and fees. Maintain a complete and accurate voucher register. Be responsible for all receipts and disbursements of the Club. Present a monthly financial statement to the President. Present his records for annual audit by three (3) members of Board of Directors.

Article IX
Expulsion of Members

Any member whose conduct shall be decided by a majority vote of the Board of Directors to have been detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Club shall forfeit his membership rights, but such vote shall not be taken without giving him and affording him an opportunity of being heard in his own defense. He may appeal from the decision of the Board of Directors to the Club at a special meeting called for that purpose, but it shall require a two-thirds vote of the members present to reverse the Board of Directors' decision.

Article X

Any amendment to these by-laws must be submitted to the Virginia Motor Sport Club, Incorporated, for its approval; if such is given, it may be presented at any specified meeting of the Club after having been sent to each member by mail at least ten days previously. A majority vote of the members in good standing present shall be necessary to adopt any amendment.
