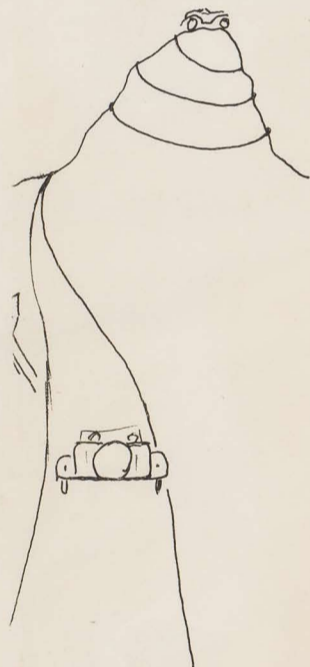
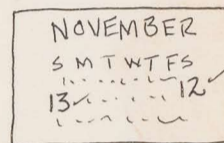



Nov. 1955 Old Dominion Rallye
