

I would like to first thank all of the members of V.M.S.C. and other clubs for supporting the "Azalea 8 Hour" and making it a resounding success by their presence as entrants. One of the "prophets of doom" in the club bet my co-O.D. that we'd loose money but much to my delight we didn't. My only complaint was the fact that a slice of pickled tomato cost me a dollar.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank the people who helped us out this rally on. Gene Atkinson and Ken Parker were indespensible they checked the rally route and instructions for us. In addition Gene and Doris Belcher ran the sweep car and Ken was control steward on check point # 9.

John Kessler on checkpoint # 1 and # 5, Mac McClintic on checkpoint # 2 and # 6, Len Wells on checkpoint # 3 and # 7, and Bill Bernard on checkpoint # 4 and # 8 did an excellent job along with their respective crews.

Jerry and Amy Cavedo did a great role as entertainment co-chairmen. Last, but not least I'd like to express my sincere appreciation to Wiltshire Greenwood. Wiltshire put in one "H___'of a lot of hours on this rally should take most of the credit for what I'll call a job well done. I'll take the blame for the mistakes.

At the end of this letter you'll find a tabulation of the evaluation forms which the contestants filled out. These seem to warrant a few comments, so I'LL take them in order.

Letter continued:

1. INSTRUCTIONS: 21 out of 22 forms said that the instructions were clear. The one dissenting vote rated them incomprehensible, this car saw only one check point all

day and he maxxed that one.

2. ROUTES: 18 rated them good and 5 accentable. One contestant said they were too rough on the car and also dangerous. I used dirt roads because I like them. They are no harder on cars than any other roads. The person who said they were dangerous must have been trying to maintain an average speed of 90 mph.

3. SPEEDS: 15 said the speeds were appropriate, 6 said they were too high and 5 said they were too low. If anyone had careully examined the roads and the checkpoint loca-

tions, he would have agreed with the speeds.

4. CHECKPOINTS: This was the "bone of contention" of the whole event. The checkpoint locations were excellent, in spite of one dissenting opinion as was their operation. The only weak point was checkpoint # 5. All except one car took the wrong route at this point (the one car that went right was a Barracuda). The cars were timed as they passed the pylon, whether they were on the wrong route or the right.

I have only one more thing to add. My wife's evaluation form gave us a perfect score. Her only comment was after the route evaluations "It was 'Right Dirty' ".






