



# In The Beginning...

The following is in response to your request for memories/anecdotes of early VMSC:

40 years! You've got to be kidding! I guess you are right, though. I remember the meeting when VMSC was founded. In the showroom of Harper Motors on Main Street in Charlottesville, Va. Mark Congdon (Dr. [M.D.] Mark Congdon) was elected the first President. Among those present at the founding meeting were Joe Crenshaw and Zeke Bookman in Zeke's new black MG-TD. Happy Batcheller was there, in a Jag most likely, and I made the scene in my Hillman Minx drophead coupe, or as we might better know it, "convertible".

Like Porter Seay, I remember bits and pieces which stand out.

The first VMSC "Field Trials" in a meadow at Warrenton. I just happened to take first in my '53 Austin Healey 100. 9-5-54 according to my dash plaque.

Rallying was what VMSC was all about, for the most part, in the early days.

Many rallies began at Tran-Sport at 1010 N. Boulevard here in Richmond. I remember one that went down Route 5 to Charles City. A 500K (Kompresser) Mercedes convertible competed--I recall following it down Route 5 watching the swing axles at work and hearing an occasional burst from the kompresser when the accelerator was floored. I think Bill Pettit came down to this one from Louisa in his DV32 Stutz Dual Cowl Phaeton.

Hounds & Hares rallies after the meetings at the Branch House ending at the Robin Inn where a good bit of car talk and beer were consumed.

Charlie Larus and I rallied together many times--not too seriously. We seemed to upset some of the competitors when they saw us sitting beside the road reading the Sunday funnies. We were a bit ahead on our time as I recall.

Racing got to be part of the scene in 1957. Bill Harding, Allen Fine, Rick Nunn, and I attended a blackboard session at Charlie Wallace's house in the D.C. area. Bill in his Alfa Guiletta, me in my Austin-Healey 100M attending weekend driving school on the original course at Marlboro, Md. In March as I recall. After one first on track session, I asked Bill for a light (everyone smoked then). Noticing his shaking hand, I asked if he was cold? "No, just scared \_\_\_\_less." So was I. SCCA racing got serious after that. In 1978 roll bars were required for the first time.

What a great time we all had when Sam and Jackie Carmine were on my pit crew (Rappahannock Seafood owners). Some cocktail party at the motel on Saturday after practice—with shrimp, lobster, and you-name—it.

I remember watching Roger Penske at driving school in a Corvette--Dick Thompson, Instructor. Also recall being passed with vigor by Roger on the course. "Move aside, son--I am really serious about this racing thing, you know."

Sam Perry racing an Elva Courier and becoming friends with Mark Donohue during his Elva Courier days--parties in Richmond with Mark in attendance.

Mo Clark in Ed Rucker's STUDELAK at Vineland, N.J. Up a one-way street the wrong way in Wilmington, Del., etc. (LOTS of etc.).

Mo was remarkably fast in his very special MG-A. After a race at Vineland, Tommy Elliott was sitting against Mo's A when a local came along and said "Boy! That thing really goes. What has he got in it?" Tommy's classic reply: "A single UNDERHANDED camshaft".

A gymkhana at Stratford Hills Shopping Center. John Thornton losing a wire wheel--seems the front wheels got reversed and the spinner spun off.

BRAVO BRITTANIA Gymkhana at Thalhimers Westmoreland. I had to drive and hold on to the rope in the "around the pylon bit" because my Lotus 7 had right hand drive.

A gymkhana at Willow Lawn. The theater manager complained--too much noise.

We certainly ought to recognize the originators of "CHECKPOINTS": Ted Remick and Bob Moore. I probably still have some copies somewhere--possibly find them by the 50th anniversary.

I could go on--somebody else's turn.

VMSC is where I made friends who shared a common interest. We are still close friends to this day.
